



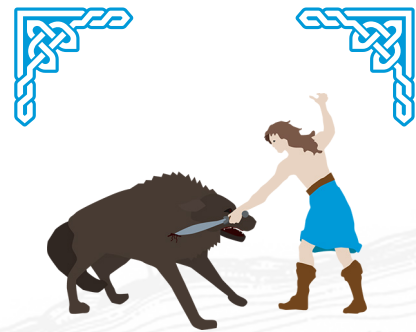

Vidar R

Vidar R is a **workboat and tug** for towing, anchor handling, pipe handling and ploughing, and is fitted with a hydraulic A-frame, as well as a towing hook. The knuckleboom crane at SWL 2 t **can handle spare parts**, and assist where necessary.

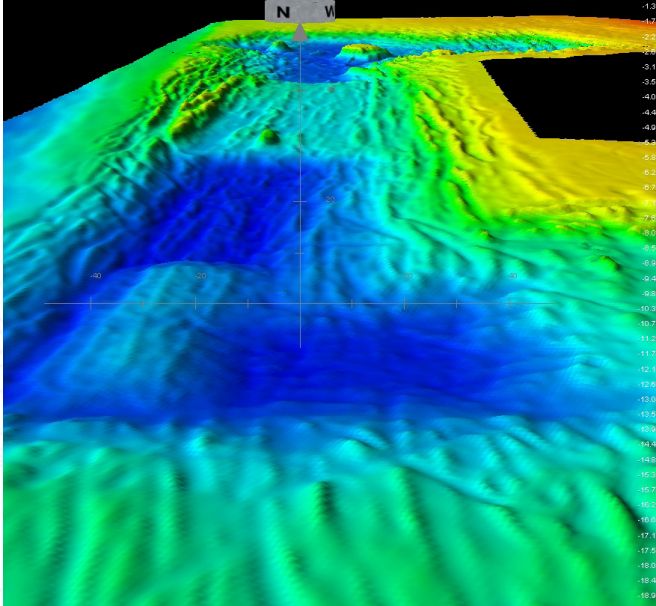
With a vertical rubber covered pushbow, Vidar R can **safely accommodate crew transfers**. A flybridge control system allows for **superior high safety maneuvering**.

With a bollard pull of 5 t, Vidar R is capable of handling **a variety of tasks**.
